Inland waters are distributed among polar ice and glaciers, actively exchanged groundwater, freshwater lakes, and human-made impoundments (farm ponds and reservoirs), saline lakes, soil water, marshes/wetlands, and rivers and streams, in the order of decreasing volume (see Table 1). Determining the extent of inland waters has been done for a long time, but currently is an active area of research.

Miracle Waters is a flooded chromium mine with approximately 6 hectare surface area. Conditions . This is an inland site and not greatly affected by weather and season. Water is fairly warm (up to 24°:C in summer), however there are several noticeable thermoclines at approximately 12, 17, and 21 metres. In winter the water will be colder.
