How to Change Manual Transmission Fluid

First check your owner's manual to make sure you know whether a flush or change of transmission fluid is typically recommended for your vehicle. When changing your transmission fluid, you open the transmission drain located on the underside of the car. This allows about 40% to 50% of the transmission fluid to drain out into the pan.

Can Changing Your Transmission Fluid Cause Damage? : M&J ...

If you're looking towards the front of the truck, the transmission will have two plugs. On the left of the transmission is the fill plug, and on the right of it is the drain plug. Place the drain pan under the drain plug, and slowly loosen it. Expect the fluid to come out strong, and weakens as it drains, so place the drain pan accordingly.

Fortunately, changing manual transmission fluid in the A4 is actually easier than changing the oil, at least in a manual transmission car, because you don't have to change the filter as well. You simply drain the old lubricant and find a way to fill the transmission with new fluid.

The most important take away however is using the correct fluid, Honda manual or GM Syncromesh fluid. In my experience using other fluids can cause shifting issues or worse bearing issues.

Completely drain the transmission fluid. Connect the transmission fluid pump to a bottle and drain out all of the fluid. Pump a small portion of new fluid into the fill plug to flush out any contaminants. Ensure that you have a little more transmission fluid than the volume listed in your owner's manual.

Procedure to Drain and Fill Manual Transmission Fluid Park the vehicle on a level surface and set the parking brake. Position a drain pan under the transmission drain plug. Remove the fill plug using a 24mm socket wrench.
