Before installing Apache and mod_perl, you usually have to become root so that the files can be installed in a protected area. A user who does not have root access, however, can still install all files under their home directory. The proper approach is to build Apache in an unprivileged location and then only use root access to install it.

To "pythonize" the Perl script you need to set directory with modules in -I option of Perl interpreter, PERL5LIB, or to put modules in some directory already in @INC as discussed in the Installation section.
